1. A submitted entry form with the \$25 entry fee will be required to reserve a spot. Entries will be accepted until all 16 spots for corn and 16 spots for cornbread have been filled. Payment can be made via one of the following:

2. Participants may submit multiple entries.
3. The cook-off site will be located at the Downtown Pavilion on Martin Luther King Blvd.
4. Tables with coverings, plates, serving cups, napkins, and spoons will be provided by the Cornbread Heritage Festival.
5. Set-up can begin at 1:45 PM. Participants MUST be set up by 2:30 PM for judging to begin promptly at the designated time.
6. Participants will serve entries to the judges and the public. Plan to have a representative at your table for the duration of the judging and the public taste tasting. Approximately 2:30 – 4:30 PM, or until the majority of participants are incapable of serving.
7. Please come prepared with the following servings:
 - Cornbread pre-cut in 2-inch squares
 - Corn on the Cob cut in 3-inch pieces
 - Corn, Street Corn, Corn Pudding, etc. will be provided with small cups for serving
8. Judging criteria will be determined by the following: Taste – 10 points; Presentation – 10 points; Originality – 10 points
9. The public will select the Fan Favorite Award. The public will be available to purchase taste-testing tickets at 5 for \$5 or 12 for \$10. The public will use tickets to taste any entry. The entry with the most tickets at the close of the taste-testing competition wins. It's up to you to entice them to try your entry and cast their vote for you!
10. Be sure to engage and answer questions about your recipe! Sell it!
11. Provide a visible display with the ingredients of your entry. We want to be mindful of food allergies for all those tasting.
12. All ingredients must come from approved food sources, so it's absolutely safe for public consumption
13. At the conclusion of the competition, please clean your area and take home any dishes.
14. Winners will be announced at approximately 4:00 PM. In each category, 1st Place will receive \$200 • 2nd Place, \$100 • 3rd Place, \$50 • Fan Favorite, a commemorative plaque and \$25.
